I have a professional history and a personal commitment of supporting issues of importance to the GLBT Community.

During the "We Are Family" controversy, I sponsored a resolution to reaffirm the board's commitment to eliminate discrimination based upon sexual orientation. I also attended press conferences and spoke out in support of the video.

I have worked with Stratton Pollitzer of Equity Florida , lobbying against the anti-bullying bill that excluded categories and working for a bill with delineated categories. We are the first board in the state to adopt an Anti-Bullying Policy protecting all students and delineating categories, including gender identity or expression and sexual orientation.

When Simmie Williams, was tragically and senselessly killed, I attended a press conference and rally in support of protecting our GLBT youth.

I have proudly supported all measures before me that seek to protect and strengthen the rights of the members of the GLBT community.
